In New Brunswick we'll visit Hopewell Cape, the location of the highest tides in the world, seeing the famous Flower Pot Rocks carved by the Fundy tides. On PEI we'll visit Green Gables Heritage Place and Charlottetown, after which we will take a ferry back to Nova Scotia and our exploration of Cape Breton Island and the fabulous Cabot Trail.
